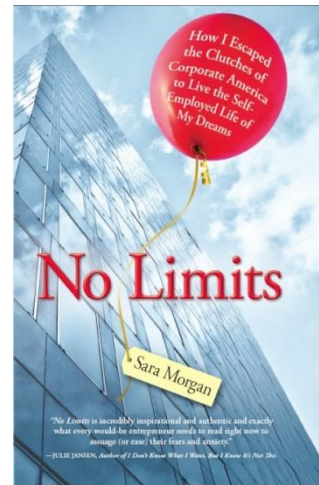


No Limits
